cinema has been long associated with france dating back to 1895 when louis and auguste lumi re screened their works the first public viewing of films anywhere early silent pioneers georges mzli s alice guy blachz and others followed in the footsteps of the lumi re brothers and the tradition of important filmmaking continued throughout the 20th century and beyond in encyclopedia of french film directors philippe rège identifies every french director who has made at least one feature film since 1895 from undisputed masters to obscure one timers nearly 3 000 directors are cited here including at least 200 filmmakers not mentioned in similar books published in france each director s entry contains a brief biographical summary including dates and places of birth and death information on the individual s education and professional training and other pertinent details such as real names when the filmmaker uses a pseudonym the entries also provide complete filmographies including credits for feature films shorts documentaries and television work some of the most important names in the history of film can be found in this encyclopedia from masters of the golden age jean renoir and renz clair to french new wave artists such as fran ois truffaut and jean luc godard

gambling captures as nothing else the drama of the long eighteenth century between the age of religious wars and the age of revolutions the society that was confronted with games of chance pursued as commercial ventures also came to grips with unprecedented social mobility floated by new wealth from new sources that created fortunes from trade in sugar cotton ivory silk tea or enslaved human beings likewise play for money was prominent in the public imagination as money itself deployed through an ever expanding and ever more sophisticated range of mechanisms increasingly invaded public awareness as when prospective spouses in period fiction were rated in terms of annual income as if they were municipal bonds similarly the archetypal figure of the gambler captured the imagination of the public in fiction media and politics at the same time new interest in science technology engineering and mathematics encouraged and bankrolled by those in power fostered a new and unprecedented appreciation for mathematical probability and its

french film noir has long been seen as a phenomenon distinct from its hollywood counterpart this book an innovative departure from conventional noir scholarship now adopts a biocultural approach to exploring the french genre through the years 1941 1959 chapters reveal noir as a product of the social and cultural factors at play in occupied liberated and post war france marked by malaise at military defeat nazi collaboration and the impact of industrialisation furthermore the book uncovers the evolutionary mechanisms of sexuality and reproduction beneath the national context that drive gendered behaviour on screen during this period for example the emerging urgent demand for population growth coupled with the severe shortage of eligible males rendered the mating game particularly perilous for traditional women beginning to enter the workplace this explains the cynical yet seductive behaviour of the femme fatale deborah walker morrison focuses on the dangerous often deadly desires of an array of male and female character types moving past the celebrated fatal femme to tragic heroines psychopathic narcissists fatal hommes and gangster anti heroes the book re examines productions by directors such as henri georges clouzot jacques becker and jules dassin and pulls together strands of sociological biological psychological and evolutionary science to create an illuminating study of the intense human passions underlying the cut throat world of noir

this book was developed to address a need quantitative literacy courses have been established in the mathematics curriculum for decades now the students in these courses typically dislike and fear mathematics and the result is often a class populated by many students who are unmotivated and uninterested in the material this book is a text for such a course however it is focused on a single idea that most students seem to already have some intrinsic interest in and is written at an accessible level it covers the basic ideas of discrete probability and shows how these ideas can be applied to familiar games roulette poker blackjack etc the gambling material is interweaved through the book and introduced as soon as the necessary mathematics has been developed throughout mathematical formalism and symbolism have

been avoided and numerous examples are provided the book starts with a simple definition of probability goes through some basic concepts like combining events and expected value and then discusses some elementary mathematical aspects of various games roulette is introduced very early on as is the game of craps which requires some knowledge of conditional probability other games like poker blackjack and lotteries whose study requires some rudimentary combinatorics come shortly thereafter the book ends with a brief introduction to zero sum games with some attention paid to the use of these ideas in studying bluffing in addition to discussion of these traditional games the author motivates probability by talking about a few applications in legal proceedings that illustrate how mathematics has been misused in the courtroom there is also a discussion of the monty hall problem a nonintuitive result in probability that has an interesting and colorful history hopefully students studying from this text will find that mathematics is not as horrible as they have always thought and offers some interesting applications in the real world this should perhaps be the goal of any quantitative literacy course
