published during the tenth anniversary of the book of common worship 1993 the companion to the book of common worship is a practical guide answering questions such as how do i use the book of common worship to its fullest advantage and how can the book of common worship form a congregation into a community that glorifies and enjoys god

liturgical theology tends towards the anthropocentric focussing primarily on the behaviour of the worshippers the theology of thomas f and james b torrance however provides an alternative approach a trinitarian and christocentric study of liturgy which decentralises the worshippers position in liturgy and focusses instead on christ the one who is worshipped in trinitarian doxology kevin j navarro examines the torrances theology explicating and illuminating their work whilst simultaneously providing critical analysis which provides a lens for deeper understanding

christians form a worshipping community so learning how to worship is an important part of being a christian there is an important concern for practical relevance in the church today but worship should not be conducted in ways that are simply hip or trendy without first ensuring that they are also theologically well grounded pragmatic questions such as does it work or is it relevant must be preceded by the question is it right some worship services have the look and feel of entertainment and the focus seems not to be on god or the gospel but on the congregation and its assets and preferences behind every act of worship there are theological ideas but such ideas are not always well grounded in the story of what god has done in jesus christ back cover
