charged with the formidable task of locating and marking German targets for attack by the main force of Bomber Command the Pathfinder Force 8 Group and those in 5 Group was perhaps the most experienced and highly trained elite group created within the Royal Air Force during World War II. Its aircrew members were almost entirely volunteers and despite the terrifying odds against any individual or complete crew ever completing the sixty sorties tour of operations with the PFF the most feared punishment was to forfeit their coveted Pathfinder wings and be posted away to other units. This remarkable evocation of a remarkable force is made up largely of narrative and photographs from the men who flew with or were an integral part of the PFF. They alone are best qualified to recount the Pathfinder story while the subject matter herein largely covers the four-engined Stirlings, Halifaxes and Lancasters and twin-engined Mosquitoes of 8 Group. The path-finding techniques used by 5 Group are not forgotten and there are two chapters detailing the work of the Oboe Mosquitoes and other markers in support of the night and day main force raids on German and Italian cities and individual targets in the Reich. This book is a fitting tribute to the PFF and in particular to the crews who failed to return from the PFF's many operations.

This is a brand new updated history of the Nuremberg raid taking advantage of new stores of information that have come to light in recent years. In his usual highly praised style Martin Bowman's historical narrative is supplemented throughout by first-hand snippets of pilot testimony offering an authentic sense of events as they played out. Having access to extensive archives of images ensures that this is a visually pleasing and comprehensive account of one of the most iconic raids of the Second World War.

george nichols was an artillery officer serving with the 82nd brigade royal field artillery he was wounded in 1917 and returned to the guns in march 1918 just in time to experience the fury of the kaiserschlacht the great german offensive designed to knock the british army out of the war nichols wrote a powerful account of the kaiser s last great offensive battle from inside the eye of the storm and it is one of the few primary source accounts which are told from the often overlooked perspective of the british artillerymen nichols with wonderful british reserve records how the men of the royal field artillery steadfastly manned their guns nichols survived the onslaught and in 1919 was able to produce a full account of both the retreat and the british counter attack which won back the lost ground first published in 1919 while censorship was still in force this wonderful primary source has long been out of print and it s welcome return makes for essential reading for anyone with an interest in the great war

of the 7 953 bomber command aircraft lost on night operations during the second world war an estimated 5 833 fell victim to luftwaffe night fighters in this detailed re enactment of the air war over western europe and the raids flown by the men of raf

bomber command the author has pieced together official data and the words and memories of the pilots and air crew who participated in the proceedings across fifteen chapters many unique experiences are regaled enlivening the history of the night bombing raids that were hurled against hitler s war machine during the latter half of the second world war they span the period between november 1943 and 1945 and cover the encounters between the luftwaffe and raf bomber command during their heyday no operation was easy was a commonly coined phrase amongst this group who night after night struck out at targets such as the the big city berlin stuttgart and the ruhr these truly epic stories gleaned from the memories of the men who made up bomber command serve as an appropriate epitaph to their collective effort

the invasion was launched to round off hitlers balkan campaign against crete in may 1941 the island was important to britains control of the eastern mediterranean and churchill was determined that the island would be held the british garrison was largely made up of new zealand and australian troops who had been evacuated from greece with little more than what they stood up in on the other hand the german commander kurt student had overwhelming air superiority which negated the allied naval superiority but the germans had almost fatally underestimated the number of allied troops while british new zealand and australian soldiers however showed what they were capable of the battle for crete was eventually won through sheer nerve the confidence of the german soldier in his superiority and the power of the luftwaffe that said the cost in killed and wounded was such that hitler would never again contemplate another large airborne operation

in 1916 sir douglas haig commanding the bef began his great offensive to drive the invaders off the ground they had been occupying for over a year and a half the great push as the offensive was advertised to the nation began 1 july 1916 a glossy picture magazine was produced to inform the british public of the progress of the offensive over a four month period until the battle of the somme faded away in november the magazine appeared with the following advertising blurb sir douglas haigs great push the battle of the somme a popular pictorial and authoritative work on one of the greatest battles in history illustrated by about 700 wonderful official photographs and cinematograph films by arrangement with the war office beautifully printed on the best english art paper as is well known the great push turned out to be little more than a nudge but for the sake of national morale the british public had to be encouraged to believe that all was going well especially in view of the horrific casualties wrecking the lives of families throughout the land the great push in the form of images of war helps capture the propaganda thrust of the times and presents once more the illustrations of those bewildering days

during the great war a german publisher produced a number of photographic books that are of considerable interest to the modern day reader these were based on the photographs taken by the german regiments that found themselves stationed there during the war this the first book covers the battle of arras in 1917 one of the largest in the war in addition to the introduction giving the historical context there are 350 photographs of the villages and towns trenches troop movements cemeteries and dealing with civilians these photos vividly convey what the areas of lens arras bullecourt havrincourt cambrai douai were like under german occupation this book is not just a memory rich diary for the thousands of soldiers who fought there but also a valuable record of the period

in 1804 liverpool was the largest slave trading port in great britain yet her influential traders felt threatened by the success in parliament of the anti slavery movement few in liverpool condemned the trade william king son of a liverpool slave trader sickened by what he experienced aboard a spanish slaver was one of the few who did speak out triangle trade set during the dying days of this despicable business has generational change moral wickedness greed romance and the fortunes of war woven through the lives of a father and son caught up in the turmoil that preceded the implementation of the british trade act of 1807 which would end britains involvement in the slave trade nineteenth century liverpool is revived a city of political conflict and dynamic change mirrored in its inhabitants as seen on historicalnovels info

a history of the british raf s 100 group the airmen ground crew and technicians who supported the strategic bomber offensive during world war ii on 23 november 1943 100 bomber support group of raf bomber command was formed the object was to consolidate the various squadrons and units that had been fighting a secret war of electronics and radar countermeasures attempting to reduce the losses of the heavy bombers and their hard pressed crews in bomber command this secret war involved the use of air and ground radars homing and jamming equipment special radio and navigational aids and intruding

night fighters to seek out and destroy their opposite numbers the ju 88s and bf 110s of the nachtjagdgeschwader who defended the night skies of the third reich with ever increasing success the book contains many first hand accounts from pilots and crew and provides a fascinating record of 100 group s wartime history

by means of interviews with and contributions from prominent international figures axis of freedom examines the dramatic world events which unfolded from 11 september 2001 to the end of occupation of iraq in the summer of 2004 many books have been written on the war on terror but none include the personal views and opinions of so many top military and political leaders the contributions are linked by a series of essays to form a compelling narrative of the new way of war in their own words the key decision makers such as donald rumsfeld richard perle and geoff hoon talk about the strategic dilemmas the military implementation of the political decisions are discussed by leaders such as the head of the us air force the former british chief of defence staff lord guthrie and the royal navy s first sea lord highly charged critiques by george galloway mp are also included as well as iraq s deputy prime minister tariq aziz who was interviewed on the eve of the war senior foreign correspondents such as channel four s lindsey hilsum add their own frontline assessments in addition leading academic analysts such as dr paul cornish put the political and military debates in context

by the end of the second world war the reputation of hitler s schutzstaffel ss had become so heavily sullied that the organization was branded criminal and banned in postwar germany it s authority in nazi germany had been enormous having been made responsible for reich internal security it implemented nazi racial policy and managed the death camps most oddly it produced a rival military organization to the german regular army fighting alongside it but never a part of it the waffen ss ss totenkopf is a photographic account of that unit s birth and first month of active service the division formed from concentration camp guards fought alongside rommel s 7th panzer division against the only british armored counterattack of the
